Annual Dues

Annual dues are \$50 for National membership and \$25 for local membership.

Alumni Membership is annual. It expires on July 31st of each year. After this date, alumni members must renew their membership status to remain active.

New Graduates: Upon graduation, student members are strongly encouraged to continue their participation with NSBE and join the NSBE Alumni Extension. Their membership dues are free to students who join within one year of graduation (a \$50 value).
